

Ten members of the **ANGEL-SALOMON** family were deported. Among them were seven children. The only photos we have show **Isaac**, age 16, born in Lille (North department), who was deported from Angers on **convoy 8**, July 20, 1942 and **Rachel**, age 14, who was also born in Lille. She was deported on **convoy 34**, September 18, 1942.

The family lived at Tharon-Plage in Saint-Michel-Chef (Loire-Inferieure department). The father, Haim, born in Smyrna; the mother, Louise, was born in Constantinople. They were all deported.

Haim was deported with the oldest children: **Esther** and Isaac, ages 15 and 16. Louise was deported on convoy 34 with the youngest ones: **Joseph**, Rachel, **Sarah**, **Jacques** and **Yvonne**, ages 13, 14, 12, 4 and only 2.

When convoy 8 left Angers, 27 deportees were taken to the camp of La Lande. They were children and old people who, as a rule, could not be deported at that time. This explains why the family had been separated.
