



Sedi et Marion

Sedi GRUMBACHER, née le 20 avril 1925, 17 ans, a vécu avant la guerre au domaine Sainte-Radegonde à Chênehutte-les-Tuffeaux (Maine-et-Loire). Elle est déportée d'Angers le 20 juillet 1942 par le convoi n° 8 avec sa mère, Fanny, et ses deux sœurs, Rita et Gerti. À droite, son amie, **Marion ABRAHAM**, déportée avec elle.

Sedi GRUMBACHER, age 17, was born on April 20, 1925 in Rust, as were her older sisters, Rita, age 21, Gerti, age 19, and their mother, Fanny. Before the war, she lived in Chênehutte-les-Tuffeaux (Maine-et-Loire department) at Domaine Sainte-Radegonde. Everyone was arrested and interned in the camp of Angers. Sedi, her mother, and sister were deported on **convoy 8**, July 20, 1942. In the photo, Sedi is standing on the left with her friend, **Marion ABRAHAM**, who was deported with Sedi.
