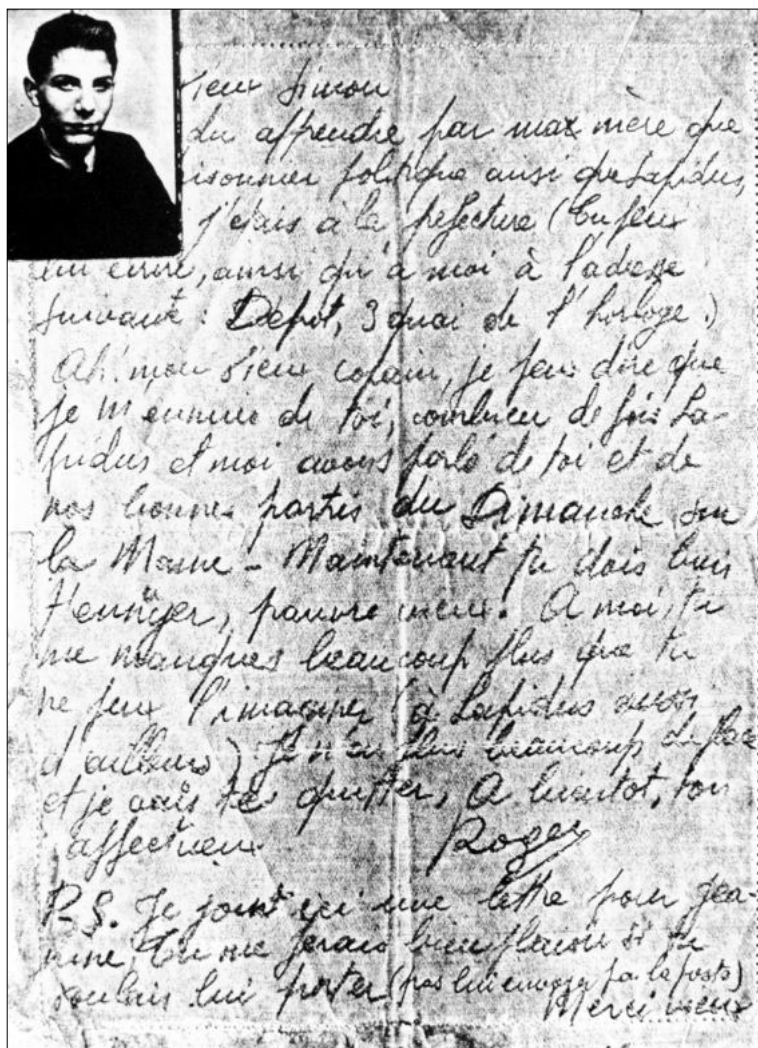


**Iser ABRAMOWICZ** avait 17 ans ; il était né à Paris où il habitait 43 rue des Boulets dans le 11<sup>e</sup> arrondissement. Il a été déporté le 31 juillet 1943 par le convoi n° 58. Son père, Idel, l'avait précédé par le convoi n° 2. Iser a été arrêté avec son ami, Bension (Jean) Lapidus qui, lui, a été déporté par le convoi n° 55.

Roger a écrit après son arrestation à son ami, Simon Ceausu, la lettre ici reproduite :



**Iser ABRAMOWICZ**, age 17, was born in Paris where he lived at 43 Rue des Boulets (11<sup>th</sup> arr.). He was arrested with his friend, Bension (Jean) Lapidus. Jean was deported first on convoy 55. Roger was deported on **convoy 58**, July 31, 1943.

After his arrest, Roger wrote the following letter to his friend Simon Ceausu :

“My old pal, Simon,

You might have heard through my mother that I am a political prisoner and so is Lapidus. I was in the Prefecture. You can write to him and to me as well at the following address “Jails, 3 quai de l’Horloge”.

Ah, my old pal, I can tell you how I miss you, how many times Lapidus and I have talked about you and about our great Sunday parties by the Marne river. Now, you must be bored, poor old pal. I miss you a lot more than you can think (same for Lapidus).

I don’t have any more space here, so I must leave you. See you soon,

Your friend, Roger.

P.S. I am enclosing a letter for Jeannine. Please bring it to her. Do not send it by mail. Thank you, old pal.”
